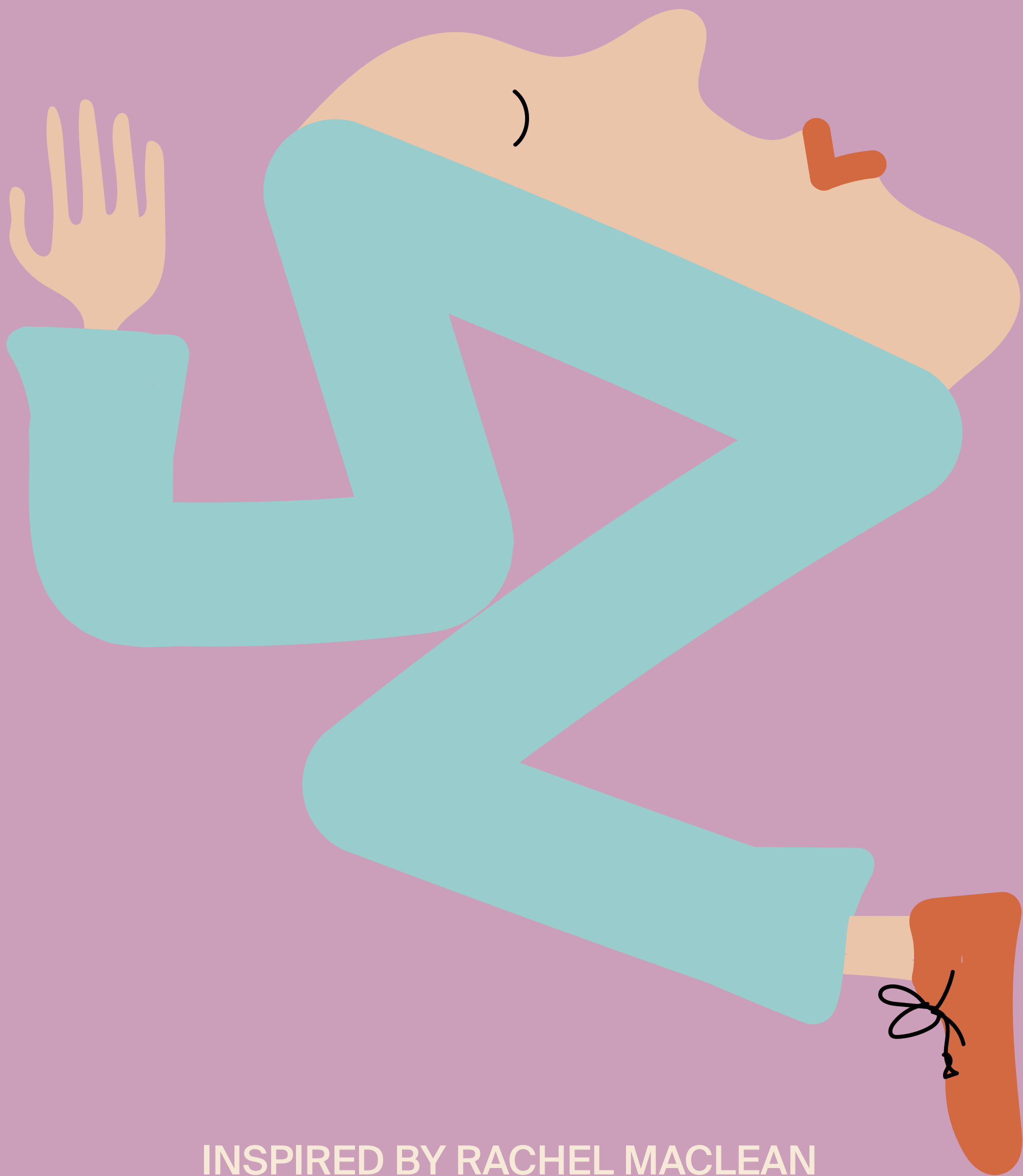

YOU WILL NEED:

3 old soft toys, good scissors, and a needle and thread

1. Find 3 old soft toys you've outgrown and no longer play with. Make sure you ask an adult's advice about which toys to use!
2. Get the scissors and cut off all arms/legs and heads, or any bits of the toy you think look interesting.
3. Feeling Better?
4. Now get sewing, swapping and replacing all the bits until you have three reinvented, rearranged toys ready to play with again!
5. What will you name your new toy? Have you created a new species of toy like a bear-doll, or a bunny-car?
